

Ohio State Club Football Constitution

ARTICLE I - Name

- The Ohio State University Club Football Program

ARTICLE II - Purpose

- The OSUCF was established to provide an opportunity for students that still have a love for the game of football but are not of the quality to play on the varsity team at The Ohio State University. It is meant to provide a competitive but fun atmosphere during practices and games.

ARTICLE III - Membership

- Any student registered with at least 6 credit hours at The Ohio State University is qualified for membership. Our club also adopts the university's non-discrimination policy statement.
- A student is expected to attend practice regularly, be on time and sign their name on the sign-up-sheet each practice.
- Club dues are required for membership. First time members will have an added membership fee for equipment purposes. The amount is usually around \$200.00. All dues are non-refundable.
- A member has the right to withdraw from the club at any time.
- A member can be terminated from the club if probable cause is brought to the attention of the officers and a 2/3 vote is achieved by the ranking officers.
- This organization and its members shall not discriminate against any individual(s) for reasons of age, color, disability, gender identity or expression, national origin, race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, or veteran status.

ARTICLE IV - Meeting

- Club meetings are TBD once we have a schedule.
- Special practice sessions or meetings may be called by the coaching staff or officers. All players shall be notified by phone or e-mail.
- Competitions will be coordinated with the National Club Football Association.

ARTICLE VI - Elections

- Elections take place in Feb/March. Paper ballots are used to elect players to each position.
- Officers may be removed from their position by a majority vote of the officers.
- Captains shall be selected by the coach and players.

ARTICLE VII – Funds

- Club funds are allocated by the officers.
- Club dues are approximately \$200 per player per season (Fall).
- All fees are non-refundable.
- Fundraising efforts are coordinated by the Sponsorship Chairman.
- All players will be expected to participate in fundraising.

ARTICLE VIII – Advisor

- The advisor currently has no responsibility to the club.

ARTICLE IX – Coach

- New coaches will be selected by current coaching staff or by the club officers.
- Coaches are currently not paid.

ARTICLE X – Travel

- The President will arrange all travel for the club with the help of the other officers.

ARTICLE XI – Amendments

- Amendments to this document can be presented to the collection of officers and approved by a majority vote between the officers.
